Council has completed the 2014 operations budget process noting specific projects to be undertaken:

- Mawson roadway/drainage work
- Dust control / road surface enhancement for all roadways with completed drainage upgrades
- Staffing schedules administration, maintenance, golf course
- Beach area enhancement

Taxes:

The Base tax has been increased by \$100. The mill rate has not changed - 2 mills. The 15% discount applies to municipal taxes only. The balance owing has been calculated at the bottom of the notice.

You are welcome to stop in and pay your taxes or utility bills, but please keep in mind that the village office is located within a private home. Office hours are part time - Monday to Friday between 9 am and 5 pm.

• Please do not 'pop in' on Weekends or Evenings.

• Please avoid putting cash in the mail box, as it is not a secure site.

Speed Limit:

Speed is limited to 30 km/hr in our village

If a constant infraction is noticed, please record, vehicle license (if possible), description, date and time - report to RCMP or bylaw enforcement (Administration) for appropriate action.

Pets:

The Animal Control Bylaw requires that pets be confined to owners' property or on a leash. The bylaw also requires that any droppings be cleaned up immediately. Fines will be issued to those who contravene the bylaw.

Docks:

A reminder to all when installing your docks and/or lifts this spring/summer: We have had reports of docks, old boats, lifts and general JUNK not being used and sitting or being stored on the shore line area. This cannot happen and we ask that you contact Jessie and or Dwayne to report any of these situations so they can be dealt with ASAP.

We are also asking everyone, when you are down at the shoreline area to be watchful for any Boats or Docks that you think might not be from the Village so we can have them checked out to see if they do indeed belong to the Shields Residents and have permits to be in these areas.

Pleasant Properties:

Efforts have been made to require all residents to maintain tidy properties. We thank those who take the time to create and enjoy their yard spaces. Please take a summer's moment to walk the village and observe the great landscaping efforts of our village residents.
