RESORT VILLAGE OF SHIELDS

BYLAW #1/18

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR COLLECTION OF COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH CONNECTING TO THE WATER SYSTEM

The Council of the Resort Village of Shields, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. That all property owners within the Resort Village of Shields shall share the \$225,000 cost to have access to the Dundurn Rural Water Utility pipeline.
- 2. That property owners currently connected to the municipal water system have contributed to this cost.
- 3. That any property not currently connected to the municipal water system and contributing to the cost of the pipeline, will upon application for a permit to construct a building on said property, be charged a connection fee of \$2000.00.
- 4. The connection fee does not apply to properties within the two new subdivisions as the fee is collected via the development fees from the developer or set aside from the sale of a lot from the Resort Village.
