## **BYLAW NO. 1/20**

## A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH REGULATIONS RESPECTING CULVERTS

The Council of the Resort Village of Shields in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw may be referred to as the "Culvert Bylaw".
- 2. Each parcel of land having access from the municipal road requiring installation of a culvert or culverts must have culverts with a minimum diameter of 304.8 mm (12 inches) and a length of not more than 9.144 meters (30 feet). A 3.048 meter (10 feet) space between neighbouring culverts is required shorter spans may be approved if a catch basin is provided.
- 3. The Resort Village of Shields shall determine whether a culvert is required and the placement of the same.
- 4. Purchase and installation of required culverts shall be the sole responsibility of the property owner and the cost shall be borne by the same.
- 5. Any individual removing or altering installed culverts shall require permission of the municipality by way of a development permit.
