Monthly Council Highlights
June 19/19

1. New Councillor, Lorna Ledoux took her Oath of Office. Welcome Lorna.
2. Council selected contractor for the construction of South Memorial Drive road. Construction is expected to begin early July – depending on the weather. It is expected that equipment will be moved into place this week - weather dependent. Instructions for residents while road is closed, etc will be provided.
3. Crime watch signs for 3 entrance points to the village approved. Signs will be installed once they arrive from supplier.
4. Dust Control for Sunterra roadways scheduled for June 25.
5. Shoreline leveling due to ice heaves completed. Issues with shoreline - contact Fred Fehr - Operations.
6. Notice sign that Heavy Equipment must report to Fred Fehr prior to entering village will be installed. This assists in preventing damage to roads, public reserves and ensures contractors are aware of operating requirements within the village.
7. Fire Board Agreement signed. This agreement establishes First Response and Fire Fighting Commission to be known as Dundurn and District Fire Commission. Services currently provided to residents are unchanged.
8. Council accepted Strategic Communication Plan and agreed on priority of initiatives for implementing the plan. Strategic Communication Plan will be shared with the residents of Shields.
9. Financial – Total monthly accounts in the amount of \$289,476.79 were approved for payment. This total includes, Saskatchewan School Tax collected up to May 19 in the amount of \$198,318.54 paid to the province in June.
