

# Resort Village of Shields Monthly Council Highlights Meeting November 19, 2019

1. Memorial Drive Extension
  - a. Construction completed – grass to be planted in spring.
  - b. Cost to date about \$202,500.
  - c. Options for warning and traffic control signs are being explored.
2. Old Street Signs the old street signs be offered for sale to the public via silent auction at the May Annual Meeting. Proceeds will go to the Sport Court.
3. Permits – one development permit was approved for waterline installation at 30 Mawson Dr.
4. Winter lake access – Due to lack of response from residents, there will not be a winter access point to the lake from the village this year.
5. Culvert policy to be drafted for approval and made available to village residents.
6. Bathroom addition – tender closes on November 28, 2019. Special Council Meeting will be held at 3:00 p.m. on November 28 to award tender. Construction is expected to proceed immediately after award of tender.
7. Permanent compost relocation options are still being investigated. The aim is to offer village residents composted materials for their yards and gardens, while providing a spot for depositing their yard waste. The location must not interfere with the esthetics of the village.
8. Letter from Provincial Association of Resort Communities of Saskatchewan thanking Shields for longtime membership was acknowledged and read.
9. Monthly accounts in the amount of \$80,052.16 were approved for payment.
10. Next Council meeting be held on Monday, December 16, 2019at 6 pm.
