Monthly Council August 17, 2020

1. Delegation- Joe Hader presentation on concerns with AirBnB short-term rentals. Letter to be sent to property owners that AirBnB short-term rental is non-compliant with zoning by-law for home occupation requirements.
2. Roads-Meeting with RM on Road Maintenance agreement to be set. South Memorial Drive -Gravelok product installation week of August 17.
3. Dedicated Lands – Survey to obtain resident input regarding proposed lease of parcels of Municipal Reserve to accommodate commercial operations. Target for survey to collect public input for Official Community Plan is early September.
4. Sunterra – Shields response sent to Sunterra lawyer, meeting requested to finalize issues. Upon request, swale elevations survey report approved for release to affected property owners.
5. Fibre Optics- RedBird advised they will fund construction of fibre optics trunk line (backbone) with a reasonable hook up fee to end users. Council approved the trunk line route in the Village.
6. Bylaw enforcement – HR Committee report presented. List of bylaws ticketable to be prepared. Council to determine next steps after election.
7. Solar Caution lights to be installed on Maintenance Building.
8. Sports Court – Outstanding issues with sports pad to be addressed with contractor.
9. Communications Committee – summer newsletter to go out with project updates.
10. August accounts of \$105,144.82 approved for payment. Includes annual payment for RCMP services of \$13,871.49, July collections of Sask School Tax of \$17,812.69 and addition to Maintenance building of \$23,915.26.
11. September meeting called by Administrator –likely 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday.
