DELEGATIONS

- Jim Twigg presented the 2020 Audited Financial Statement.

PERMITS/BYLAWS/POLICY

- development permit and building permit applications approved for a garage at 11 McCordick St
- development permit, building permit applications for a sunroom alteration at 18 Hordern St. approved subject to building Inspector approval.

SUNTERRA SUBDIVISION DEVELOPMENTS

- Revised agreement is still being prepared by solicitor.

PROJECTS

ANIMAL CONTROL COMMITTEE
