• The village approved that the Dundurn Fire Department's request to waive hall rental fees be waived, with any charges for cleaning to be paid by the DFD.

Garbage Bylaw

• The village approved the Garbage Bylaw 7/23 to amend Bylaw 4/23. New rates were sent out to the residents and will be applied to the March 31 billing

Maintenance

- Maintenance will be going through all the equipment and performing the necessary repairs and maintenance on them.
- Year-end water meter reads are complete.
- Fred obtained quotes from Acadia for paving the roadway into the village. More research will be done in 2024.

Administration

- The village approved the purchase of a new projector for up to \$1,500.00.
- •The village approved that the Administration develop a procedure to collect pet registration information from each new resident who moves into the village.
- The village approved that any outstanding village payments will be applied to the Tax Roll.
