- The audit work for the 2022 year-end has begun with the audit scheduled for January 31, 2023
- Council approved that the Village auditing services for 2023 remain with Jensen Stromberg Chartered Professional Accountants.

Maintenance

• That the Resort Village of Shields will enter into an agreement for 2022 with Basic Installations Inc for Community Mailbox Snow Removal.

Building Permits

• The village approved that Dwayne Williams of Sandstar Developments Incorporated, be appointed as the Acting Building Inspector for the Resort Village of Shields

Loraas Disposal/Organics Program

Agreed that a survey will be sent out in February regarding the organics program.

Committee Reports

DAWWU

• Sewer Levy - Council approved a motion to abate the \$200 per resident sewer levy outlined in Bylaw 6/14 for 2022.

Human Resource

- Council agreed that the Council, Administrator and Operations Manager of the Resort Village of Shields register for Asset Management of Saskatchewan Training.
- Council approved a rate range increase for the Greenskeeper position \$20-\$25 hour based on experience.
- The Greenskeeper position will be posted the beginning of February and close mid-February.

Parks, Beaches Playgrounds Committee

 Council agreed to consider using the SK Lotteries funding to fund a new skating rink by the Sportscourt for next winter. This would be a volunteer project for the winter of 2023-24 located south of the Sport Court, with all materials to be completely removed from the site by April 30.

Community Centre

- Council approved the Under 11 Battalion Hockey Team's request to waive the January 14, 2023, hall rental, with any hall cleaning charges to be paid by the hockey team.
- Council established a new rental rate of \$25/hour for physical activity classes where the
 instructor is charging a fee. The kitchen will not be used for these types of rentals with
 only the floor space to be used.

Library

• The village is looking for two new appointees for the Library Board. Council thanks Judy Rathie, who has served as our representative on the Dundurn Library Board, and Cindy Sjoberg, who was appointed to the Wheatland Regional Library Board. We have appreciated their valuable contributions and thank them for serving in these roles.
