April 6, 2020: The Saskatchewan Public Safety Agency is encouraging people to download

the <u>SaskAlert App</u> so they can receive critical COVID-19 information in a timely manner. The app also allows people to choose how and when to hear the emergency alerts. They note "The more people that have the app, the more efficient we can be with targeting people in a specific area, including your jurisdiction, that might require

emergency information."

March 29, 2020: Joint Message from Shields & Thode Council

March 25, 2020: Aden's Park playground structures and work stations are closed until further notice as

mandated by the Provincial Government. This action was necessary because the shared surfaces people touch, especially playground equipment should not be used

right now for the health and safety of our children and families.

The Community Centre and public washrooms will remain closed until further notice. When COVID-19 restrictions regarding distancing and gathering limits are relaxed, the

Village will review all closures of our public facilities.

March 24, 2020: The Village Office is closed to <u>public access</u> until further notice. Utility payments can be

made by mail, drop off box or by electronic transfer. If dropping off, please call the

office first. Do not put cash in the mail box.

March 24, 2020: Provincial COVID-19 info as of March 20, 2020 - All travellers returning from

international destinations including the United States – are subject to a mandatory self-

isolation order of 14 days.
