

2020 Amendments to the Annual Waterworks Information Available at the Municipal Office by September 1 of each year.

The current **Waterworks Rate Policy** and **Waterworks Capital Investment Strategy** were amended as of February 2018.

The amendments to reserves are as follows:

- The increase of the Water System Funded Reserve to indicate that \$402,024 has been allocated to the end of December, 2019.
- The Water System Reserve from development fees remains at \$64,000.
- There is \$23,174.24 in the Utility Surplus from 2019 operations
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ANNUAL FINANCIAL OVERVIEW (of the previous calendar year)

Total Waterworks Revenue	\$132,451
Total Waterworks Expenditures	\$126,302
Total Debt Payments on Waterworks Infrastructure Loans -	\$0

Comparison of waterworks revenues to expenditures plus debt payments, expressed as a ratio:

$$\frac{\$132,451}{\$126,302} = 1.05 \text{ (for 2019, the waterworks revenues covered 100\% of the waterworks expenditures.)}$$

** A loan for the sewer system is being repaid at \$36,735.19 per year which includes interest at 4.3%
