

2023 Amendments to the Annual Waterworks (refers to Water & Sewer Operations) Information Available at the Municipal Office by September 1 of each year.

The current **Waterworks Rate Policy** and **Waterworks Capital Investment Strategy** were amended as of February 2018.

The amendments to reserves are as follows:

- The Water System Funded Reserve of \$533,697 has been allocated to the end of December 2022.
- The Water System Reserve from development fees remains at \$66,000.
- There is \$0 in the Utility Surplus from 2022 operations.

ANNUAL FINANCIAL OVERVIEW (of the previous calendar year)

Total Waterworks Revenue \$205,053

Total Waterworks Expenditures \$240,038

Total Debt Payments on Waterworks Infrastructure Loans \$36,735

Comparison of waterworks revenues to expenditures plus debt payments, expressed as a ratio:

$$\frac{\$205,053}{\$276,773} = 0.741 \text{ (for 2022, the waterworks revenues covered 74\% of the waterworks expenditures.)}$$

** A loan for the sewer system is being repaid at \$36,735.19 per year which includes interest at 4.3%
