

SHIELDS MULTI-SPORT COURT JULY 2020 UPDATE

Construction has begun! The asphalt pad was installed this past week (July 17th) and is now curing and waiting to be sealed. Next is Phase II of the construction which will include installation of the fence, power, lighting, nets and line painting. The target date for completion is early fall but it all depends on the availability of suppliers and challenges with Covid restrictions.
