Women: Round 1 9:00 to 11:00 a.m. Men: Round 1 – 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

Round 2 1:00 to 3:00 p.m. Round 2 – 3:00 to 5:00 p.m.

Tee Times to be assigned at 10-minute intervals **Championships Announced at 5:30 p.m.**

Championship Golf Rules

1. Winter rules apply.

- 2. All lost balls or unplayable balls that are not out of bounds (i.e. water or trees) will count as one stroke penalty. Continue play from point of entry.
- 3. Out of Bounds (anything beyond the boundary lines)

Hole 4 –northern boundary is the chain link fence (by #5 tee box) and the white rope. Hole 6,7, 8 –western boundary is Sunterra fence.

- a. If there is a chance your ball is out of bounds, shoot a provisional from the tee box which will be the third stroke. Do not attempt to retrieve your ball from private property.
- b. If ball lands in out of bound area anytime during play, drop ball at point of entry and take a 2-stroke penalty. (this does not apply if a provisional is used at the tee box refer to 3a)
- 4. All putts must be played no GIMMIES.
- 5. Maximum number of strokes in one hole is 8.
- 6. Hole 3 tee shots that are plugged around the green can be lifted, cleaned and placed.
- 7. Man made structures i.e. bird houses, fences, sheds if swing is impeded by the structure relief is given two club length no closer to the pin with no penalty.
- 8. If playoff holes are required, they will be played directly after 18 holes (men or ladies) have been completed and before the start of the final 9 holes for men or ladies. Playoff holes will be alternating between holes 1, 9, 1 etc.
- 9. Sand Trap Due to COVID rakes are not allowed. If the ball lands in a large footprint or divot in the sand trap, the ball may be lifted and placed in the sand trap no closer to the hole.
