Shields has an active Emergency Measures Organization that includes Council, Operations, Administration, EMO Planning Committee and Co-ordinators as well as 17 Block Captains assigned to all areas of Shields. *BE PREPARED*.....Review Shields '[Resident Emergency Response Plan](#)' to prepare you and your family in case an emergency is called in our Village. The Block Captain for your area can be found in the Plan.

Shields Emergency Measures maintains a listing of resident information for emergency purposes. Each year Shields' Block Captains connect with new residents in their area to obtain contact information that is necessary for the process. All Block Captains have badges to identify themselves and will be connecting with their residents over the spring and summer to update our documentation.
