AE's update on Construction August 9-14, coming weeks August 15-22

Overview:

The contractor, Subterra has been actively planning, drilling, and installing the low-pressure Force Main line in collaboration with Associated Engineering and the Village of Shields. Please note Subterra will be working Aug 16-17 weather dependent through into next week. The next weekend off is unsure but will likely not be until September long weekend

Progress This Week:

After dealing with heavy rain on Friday and Saturday of last week and not being able to work those days, Subterra completed drilling, pulling, and fusing together main line on McCrimmon Crescent back to Memorial Drive along with installing required Valves and Combination Air/Vacuum Valve (CAV) at the Southern McCrimmon/Memorial intersection

Subterra has continued to Hydrovac and locate existing utilities down future drill paths to ensure confidence when drilling

Construction Activity Planned for this Week:

Subterra plans on completing the final tie-ins on McMillan and McCrimmon as well as tidying up any excavation holes that are now fully installed. Once this area is wrapped up early this week, Subterra will work their way north and move down Proctor Drive, McCordick Street and Hordern Street.

Once again, we advise residents to be mindful of parking in these areas starting early next week down the first stretch of Proctor and then continuing north through the village.
